1. RULES

The rules of the competition are:

- 1.1 The rules of *Les Règles de Course à la Voile (RCV)*,
- 1.2 The national rules concerning foreign competitors as in the annexe « Prescriptions »
- 1.3 The federal regulations.
- 1.4 **The** regulations of the Police of the Lake
- 1.5 The Notice of Race
- 1.6 The class rules
- 1.7 The French text of the Notice of Race is deciding the interpretation of the rules.

2. PUBLICITY

As stated in ISAF Regulation 20 (Publicity Code), as modified by the *règlement de publicité de la FFVoile*, the boats may be required to advertise using material distributed by the organising authority.

3. ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION

- 3.1 The competition is open to: wooden boats of the class **Dinghy 12'** conforming the rules of the class Dinghy 12' France.
- 3.2 Boats meeting the requirements for admission can register using the attached form, sending it, together with the registration fee to: **YACHTING CLUB DU DER – Port Nemours – BP 192 – 52104 SAINT-DIZIER CEDEX** or at the web site of the club www.ycder.com latest at 30 June 2019 and/or by filling the form on Friday July 5 at the YCDER.
- 3.3 Every crew member in the competition in possession of a license by FFVoile has to present at registration :
 - its FFVoile license with the medical stamp, together with a medical declaration stating that she/he has no counter-indications to practising the sport of competition sailing of less than a year old, and, when of minor age, a authorisation by the parents.
 - if necessary, the authorisation of the port of publicity
 - the certificate of measurement conformity
- 3.4 All crew al participating foreign boats with no license by FFVVoile have to present at registration :
 - proof of belonging to a National Authority that is member of ISAF.
 - the certificate of measurement conformity
 - proof of insurance with a coverage of 1.5 million Euros at least.,
 - a medical declaration (in French or English) stating that she/he has no counter-indications to practising the sport of competition sailing of less than a year old, and, when of minor age, a authorisation by the parents.

6. COURSE INSTRUCTIONS

The course instructions with possible annexes will be available at the session of confirmation of registration, on July 5, and will be posted according to the Federal Rules.

7. THE COURSES

7.1 The courses are of type : Constructed or touring

7.2 The race area is specified in the annex RACE AREA

8. SYSTEM OF PENALTIES

The penalty of two rounds for an offence against a rule of Chapter 2 is substituted by a penalty of 1 round.

9. CLASSIFICATION

9.1 At least 1 course should be declared valid to form a series.

9.2 If less than 4 courses are declared valid, the score of a boat shall be the total of its score in all courses.

If 4 to 7 courses are declared valid, the score of a boat shall be the total of its score in all courses while deducting the worst score.

If 8 or more courses are declared valid, the score of a boat shall be the total of its score in all courses while deducting its 2 worst scores.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in urgencies, a boat is not permitted to use radio. This includes cell phones.

11. PRIZES

Prizes are awarded as follows :

- **The top three of the classification**
- **A prize for the first female competitor**
- **A prize for the first dinghy built before 2000**
- **A prize for the first dinghy built before 1960**

12. DECISION TO COMPETE

The decision to compete is entirely the responsibility of the participant. Therefore, by the decision of the participant to compete or keep competing, she/he discharges the organising authority of every responsibility in case of damage (material or corporal)
